



Pocket Board is the main teaching/learning tool in the Kajoli Model, which is made of cloth. It is called “**Pocket Board**” because when the piece of cloth is stitched it makes a large number of pockets in which “**Pocket Cards**” are inserted.



Cards are made by board paper in which alphabets, words, numbers and images are printed. The Pocket Board and pocket cards are used to recognize alphabets, letters/sound, and numbers. These boards and cards are also used to construct words and sentences. The size of a Pocket Board is normally about 6 feet in length and 4 feet in width. In the Kajoli Model, pocket board and pocket cards are alternative learning method which replaces the use of books in learning.
